I'd love a facility like this but unfortunately I don't see it's financial viability to be self sufficient. Which means...massive rate hikes which I'm definitely not in favour of.

Now Collier to close one of the 9 hole courses to make way for this!
Sure they could keep Collier Park golf as is and still have the aquatic centre positioned elsewhere. 🙄

Will definitely result in higher rates 🙄. Collier Park Golf is a major revenue source for CoSP and to reduce from 27 to 18 holes available will result in a 33% reduction of income. Based on financial performance of Leisureplex centres in Canning and Melville LGA's the aquatic and gym services are unlikely to cover the reduction.
Happy to save CoSP costs and use neighbouring facilities.

Where are you going to get the money? The council is broke! Don't expect the ratepayers to stump up for this. Don't you people realise there is a pandemic at present and our economy is in tatters. get real a scrap this project now.
